Did you know: As part of the government's Living with COVID-19 plan, from 1 April, it removed the health and safety requirement for every employer to explicitly consider COVID-19 in their risk assessments, with the exception of those who specifically work with the virus, such as in laboratories. Its intention is "to empower businesses to take responsibility for implementing mitigations that are appropriate for their circumstances. But UNISON is concerned that the move will contradict employers' existing duties under the Management of Health and Safety at Work Regulations, to make a suitable and sufficient assessment of the risks to the health and safety of employees while at work. Christina McAnea writes: "As a highly transmissible airborne virus, SARs-CoV-2 will continue to present a foreseeable risk to the health of workers regardless of their working environments. **Let us know if you have H&S concerns in your workplace**
