Logal Govit and FE Pay Claim news.....

Further Education employers side made a first and final offer of 1% rise on all pay points or £250 whichever is the greater.

UNISON is holding an indicative eballot and is recommending rejection of the offer. A vote to reject would require being prepared to take sustained industrial action. Eballot closes 17th Nov

Ruth Levin, Unison's national officer for FE, said the UNISON National committee voted to recommend rejection as the offer represented a "real-terms pay cut", given that inflation is "running at nearly three per cent

Local Covt. Pay Claim -

The trade unnion side have submitted the following claim ... The deletion of NIC pay points SCP 6-9 to reach the Foundation Living Wage of £8.45 (UK) and £9.75 (London) and a 5%

increase on all NJC pay points.

Delegates Report UNISON National Disabled Members' Conference 2017



UNISON National Disabled Members' Conference 2017 was held 28th – 30th October in Manchester. Notts County branch sent 3 delegates and all said it was a brilliant conference. There were several speakers including the Shadow Disabilities Minister Marsha De Cadova MP for Battersea. Also, there were lots of really interesting motions including;

Disability Workers' Charter

This would see all employers signing up to give employees protected rights at work.

Disability Passport

This could be a database of employees with protected characteristics being held by HR or Occupational Health and would eliminate the difficult task of an employee explaining their position every time they have a change of manager. This is particularly helpful for members with a hidden or non-apparent disability.

Mental Health "first aider"

This would create more awareness in the workplace. Stress, anxiety and depression are the reason for 1 in 4 visits to the GP – employers need to do more.

IMPORTANT NOTICE: ELECTION OF STEWARD

To serve the interests of our members effectively, Notts UNISON needs to be well organised and ensuring this is the responsibility of all members of the Branch.

To be well organised we need to have Stewards in all workplaces. Stewards are volunteers who are prepared to devote some of their time to helping provide us with a UNISON Branch able to represent us and act effectively on our behalf.

Are you willing to help the Branch and its members, including yourself, by becoming a Steward?

WHAT IT WILL INVOLVE

A basic duty of a Steward is to ensure that all members in your "constituency" receive UNISON literature (such as the Branch Newsletter and notices of meetings) regularly. It also involves helping any of your members who have problems at work, either by giving advice yourself (obtained through training and experience), obtaining advice from others on their behalf or (with more complex problems) in passing them on to a more experienced Officer or Steward.

Stewards are also encouraged to attend Stewards' Meetings to discuss service conditions matters in their Department or sector. These meetings are usually every month and, in most Departments, in work time. Stewards are also asked to ensure that their Department is represented at meetings of the Branch Committee which take place every six weeks, to discuss Branch policies and activities. The Steward also plays an important role in approaching new members of staff to join UNISON.

TIME AND TRAINING

Under Agreements with the County Council and other employers, many of the duties of a Steward can be undertaken during working time. The Branch provides training for all new Stewards and, again, under the Agreement with employers such training takes place in work time, with full pay guaranteed.
